## **About the Northern NSW Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Player Scholarship**

The Northern NSW Football Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Player Scholarship (the Scholarship) is an initiative of Northern NSW Football (NNSWF), which has been established to provide funding assistance to Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander players to represent NNSWF at the National Youth Championships in 2023.

The Scholarship provides support, as outlined below, for up to two (2) Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander players. The two (2) scholarships will be awarded to one (1) male player and one (1) female player.

The Scholarship will provide assistance (per player) as follows:

<b>Football Boot Allowance</b>	Up to \$200
<b>Talented Support Program (Cycle 1)</b>	Up to \$180
<b>Talented Support Program (Cycle 2)</b>	Up to \$130
<b>Talented Support Program (Cycle 3)</b>	Up to \$130
<b>Talented Support Program (Cycle 4)</b>	Up to \$130
<b>TSP Tournament</b>	Up to \$150
<b>TSP Tournament</b>	Up to \$150
<b>National Youth Championship</b>	Up to \$2,000



## **Strategic Goals**

The Scholarship addresses the following Northern NSW Football Strategic Goals:

### NNSWF Focus Area: Participating

- Address why participants leave the game and implement initiatives which will make the game more inclusive and accessible by addressing the barriers to initial participation

### NNSWF Focus Area: Talent Development

- Increase the opportunities for talents players to be engaged in the Talented Player Pathway
- Improve the technical standard of players at every level of the game, creating a larger pool of talented players
- Enhance and increase the opportunities for talented girls throughout the Talented Player Pathway

This Scholarship addresses the following FA Principles:

### FA XI Principles

Principle I: Build a consistent and strong identity for Australian football which inspires All Australians:

- Connect with our Indigenous heritage and our diverse history;
  - Develop a clear plan for the development and growth of Indigenous football that creates opportunities in football for Indigenous talent whilst also making meaningful contribution to reconciliation

Principle IV: Resetting and rebuilding Australian football products

- National Premier Leagues
  - Create more opportunities for our best players at each age group to play with and against the best



## Scholarship Objectives

The objectives of the Program are:

1. Reduce barriers for Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander players in the Talented Player Pathway;
2. Increase opportunities for Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander players to engage in player development; and
3. Identify and support the next generation of Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander players who have potential to play at the highest level of the game

## Who is Eligible to Apply for the Scholarship?

- Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Players who are registered as a Player within the national [PlayFootball](#) registration system and who intend to register in 2023.
- Age requirement:
  - Boys turning 13 - 16 in the 2023 calendar year<sup>1</sup>
  - Girls turning 13 - 17 in the 2023 calendar year<sup>2</sup>

## Who is Ineligible to Apply for the Scholarship?

- Players with a non-Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander background.
- Players who are playing for A-League Academies
- Players who are not registered within the national [PlayFootball](#) registration system to a NNSWF Zone/Club. This includes but not limited to:
  - Players registered at club affiliated to another Member Federation.

## Assessment Process

An initial eligibility assessment will be undertaken to determine that:

- The Applicant is eligible to apply;
- The application meets the Scholarship criteria and is submitted by the closing date.

A panel of representatives from NNSWF’s Talent Development department will assess the merit of all eligible applications and score each applicant against the assessment criteria.

The NNSWF Head of Football Development and Female Participation & Inclusion Officer will assess recommendations from the panel and approve the distribution of the Scholarships.

**Assessment Criteria**

Applications will be assessed on merit and scored against the following criteria:

- Current registered player
- Playing history
- Technical assessment if deemed necessary by NNSWF’s Technical Department
- Letter of Support from Regional Zone or Premier Club Technical Director that confirms a position in a Premier Competition Program has or will be offered to the applicant
- Applicants from Football Far North Coast will be required to provide a Letter of Support from their Club Technical Director or NNSWF Technical Advisor-FFNC

**Scholarship Time Frame**

NNSWF will open applications for the Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Player Scholarship on 29 November 2022 and close on 16 December 2023.

Successful Applicants will be announced in January 2023.

<b>Stage 4</b>	<b>TSP Tournament 2</b>	Up to \$150	School Holidays 2023
<b>Stage 5</b>	<b>Talent Support Program (Cycle 3)</b>	Up to \$130	June 2023
<b>Stage 6</b>	<b>Talent Support Program (Cycle 4)</b>	Up to \$130	October 2023
<b>Stage 7</b>	<b>National Youth Championships</b>	Up to \$2,000	September 2023 <sup>4</sup>

The Scholarship time frame is based on the 2021/2022 schedule of events. The Scholarship time frame is subject to change and is at the absolute discretion of NNSWF.

## Notification

Successful applicants will be notified in writing, with details of how to accept the Scholarship.

Applicants who are unsuccessful will also be notified in writing of the outcome of their application.

## **Payment of Scholarship**

Successful Applicants will be required to enter into a Scholarship agreement. Scholarship agreements must be signed and sent back to Northern NSW Football before the Scholarship can commence.

Payment of the scholarship is triggered by the selection of the recipient for the respective stages as outlined above. Selection for progression through stages is determined by performance and reassessed at the end of each stage. If, at any time during the scholarship, the recipient is assessed and determined not to proceed to the next stage, the scholarship will terminate.

With the exception of the football boot allowance, at no stage during the scholarship will Northern NSW Football provide cash amounts to scholarship recipients. Payment of scholarship amounts will occur directly by Northern NSW Football on behalf of scholarship recipients.

Scholarships must be completed by 31 December 2023.

## **Privacy Policy**

NNSWF will collect and store the information the Applicant voluntarily provides to enable processing of the application. Any information provided by the Applicant will be stored on a database that will only be accessed by authorised personnel and is subject to privacy restrictions.

The capacity to efficiently assess an application is conditional upon the Applicant submitting a complete and accurate application. Applications may be deemed ineligible if all information is not provided.

Apart from organisational and Applicant contact details, information provided in applications cannot be changed after the closing date.
